

ORDINANCE.

No. 10.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC GROUNDS: PROHIBITING THE THROWING OR DEPOSITING OF GLASS, STONES, TACKS, NAILS, CINDERS OR ASHES OR OTHER SHARP EDGED OR POINTED OBJECTS THEREON: AND PROVIDES A PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sedgwick, Colorado.

SECTION, 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to throw or deposit any glass, stones, tacks, nails, cinders, ashes or other sharp edged or pointed objects on any street, alley or other public grounds in the corporate limits of the Town of Sedgwick, Colorado. Provided however that nothing herein shall apply to the use of stones or cinders or other similar material in the repair of Streets and Alleys by the Town authorities.

Section, 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be fined a sum of not less than One Dollar nor more than Five Dollars and costs of suit for each and every offense.
