ORDINANCE NO. 04-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF SEDGWICK OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE TO ALLOW COMMERCIAL GREENHOUSES AS A CONDITIONAL USE IN THE LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, in 2002, the Town of Sedgwick Board of Trustees adopted an official zoning ordinance ("Zoning Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, Section 2.B.1 of the Zoning Ordinance sets forth special review uses in the Low Density Residential (R-LD) zoning district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to amend Section 2.B to allow commercial greenhouses as a conditional use in the Low Density Residential (R-LD) zoning district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SEDGWICK, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 2.B.1 of the Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of a new subsection (i) as follows (words to be added are <u>underlined</u>):

B. CONDITIONAL USES PERMITTED

The Board of Trustees and the granting of a conditional use permit, as prescribed in Section 3, shall allow the following uses in the applicable districts subsequent to approval:

- 1. Low Density Residential (R-LD)
- i. Commercial greenhouse, excluding retail and medical marijuana cultivation facilities.
- <u>Section 2.</u> All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.
